What is TASSP?

Therapeutic After-School and Summer Programs (TASSP) are structured programs that consist of a range of individualized therapeutic, recreational and socialization activities for youth.

These individual and group therapeutic experiences assist youth in developing social, communication, behavior and basic living skills, as well as psychosocial and problem solving skills.

Therapeutic After-School and Summer Programs are a collaboration between provider agencies, community-based organizations, professionals and/or other entities.
