 - Here are the types of services that are available:
 - Screening and Benefit Navigation: a toll-free hotline offering access to benefit navigators to assist the callers with securing resources to address behavioral health concerns.
 - 5-Session Professional Assistance Program: A program for individuals who do not have access to behavioral health services for whatever reason.
